

## I. H. ASPER SCHOOL OF BUSINESS / RED RIVER COLLEGE JOINT PROGRAM

The *I.H. Asper School of Business* (Faculty of Management) at the University of Manitoba and *Red River College* have established a Joint Program whereby graduates of the Business Administration Diploma (University Stream) at Red River College may seek admission to the Bachelor of Commerce (Honours) program at the University of Manitoba. Successful applicants will receive block transfer credit for their courses completed at Red River College and will be required to complete 72 credit hours of courses at the University of Manitoba in order to receive the B.Comm.(Hons.) degree.

Admission to the Asper School of Business/Red River College Joint Program is limited to an annual quota and is competitive. Students must achieve a minimum grade point average of 3.00 on their Business Administration Diploma (University Stream) to be eligible for admission to the Joint Program. Applicants are ranked in descending order of their grade point average and are admitted in that order until the annual quota is met.

## REQUIRED COURSE WORK AT *UNIVERSITY OF MANITOBA*:

### Qualifying Year Courses (12 credit hours):

MATH 1520 (former 136.152) *OR* MATH 1500 (former 136.150) Introduction to Calculus - 3 credit hours  
 MATH 1310 (former 136.131) *OR* MATH 1300 (former 136.130) Matrices or Linear Algebra - 3 credit hours  
 3 or 6 credit hour course that satisfies the University Written English requirement  
 (3 credit hours of non-Business electives if a 3 credit hour Written English course is selected)

(Note: These courses must be taken either during the summer term prior to the student's admission to the Asper School of Business or during the first year at the University of Manitoba. Also, students who have not taken Math 40S (pre-Calculus) in High School will be required to take the University of Manitoba's Extended Education course in Mathematical Skills prior to enrolling in Calculus. RRC Joint Program students who take the Mathematical Skills course will be allowed to use it as a 3 credit hour elective.)

### Core Courses (21 credit hours):

ACC 1110 (former 009.111) Introductory Managerial Accounting (3 credit hours)  
 MIS 2000 (former 009.200) Management Information Systems (3 credit hours)  
 GMGT 2120 (former 027.212) Business/Government Relations (3 credit hours)  
 GMGT 4010 (former 027.401) Administrative Policy (3 credit hours)  
 OPM 2600 (former 164.260) Fundamentals of Production and Operations Management (3 credit hours)

\*\*\*\*\* Critical Thinking Requirement (3 credit hours)

Students may fulfil this requirement by completing one of the following courses: PHIL 1200 (former 015.120) (6 hrs); PHIL 1290 (former 015.129) (3 hrs); PHIL 1320 (former 015.132) (6 hrs); or PHIL 2850 (former 015.285) (3 hrs). If a 6 credit hour course is chosen, three credit hours will count toward the core Critical Thinking requirement and three credit hours will count as electives.

\*\*\*\*\* Ethics Requirement (3 credit hours)

Students may fulfil this requirement by completing one of the following courses: PHIL 2290 (former 015.229) (6 hrs); PHIL 2740 (former 015.274) (3 hrs); PHIL 2750 (former 015.275) (3 hrs); PHIL 2790 (former 015.279) (6 hrs); PHIL 2830 (former 015.283) (3 hrs); PHIL 2840 (former 015.284) (3 hrs); RLG 1420 (former 020.142) (3 hrs); or GMGT 3581 (former 027.358F) (3 hrs). If a 6 credit hour course is chosen, three credit hours will count toward the core Ethics requirement and three credit hours will count as electives.

### Major Courses (12 credit hours):

12 credit hours in one of the approved Business Majors

(Note: RRC Joint Program students who want to major in Finance will be required to take FIN 2200 (former 009.220) Corporation Finance (3 credit hours) as one of their Business Options (see below) and achieve a minimum grade of C+. Likewise, RRC Joint Program students wishing to take the Management of Organizations major will be required to take GMGT 2080 (former 027.208) Organization Theory (3 credit hours) as one of their Business Options (see below).

### Business Options (15 - 18 credit hours):

15-18 credit hours of advanced Business courses

### Electives (9 - 12 credit hours):

9 - 12 credit hours of non-Business courses
